THE 2022 LEGISLATIVE SESSION: WEEKS 1-2



The Opening Day of this year's legislative session set the tone for what will be one of our most productive yet. And while a myriad of challenges awaits, one thing is certain...we are up to the task and ready to protect the will and the wallets of Floridians.

Together, we've made tremendous progress during our first two weeks in session! Below are a few of the most notable accomplishments we've made since we gaveled in on Jan. 11.

WEEK 1 (JAN. 11-14)

During his opening day remarks, Speaker Sprowls highlighted five exciting pieces of legislation filed for the 2022 Legislative Session which covered affordable housing, law enforcement support, individual freedom provisions, abortion and consumer data privacy. [CLICK HERE](#) to learn more.

In committees, we approved a wide range of bills, including those that strengthen nursing home transparency, extend COVID-19 liability protections passed last year for health care entities, and implement the voter-approved constitutional amendment lobbying restrictions.

The two Transportation Facility Designation bills I'm sponsoring this session (HB315 and HB331) to honor the late Rev. Murray Hamilton, Sr and Ira Mae Wells-Bruce passed the Tourism, Infrastructure & Energy Subcommittee. They have been both referred out to the Infrastructure & Tourism Appropriations Subcommittee next.

WEEK 2 (JAN. 17-21)

The Florida House continued to work on important issues facing Floridians during the second week of the 2022 Legislative Session.

In committees, we approved a wide range of bills, including those that protect life, promote parents' rights, increase school board accountability, support law enforcement, and improve ethics in government.

Additionally, CS/HB1035: Incorporation of Municipalities gained traction as it passed its first committee stop in the Local Administration & Veterans Affairs Subcommittee. CELEBRATE LITERACY WEEK FLORIDA, JAN. 24-28

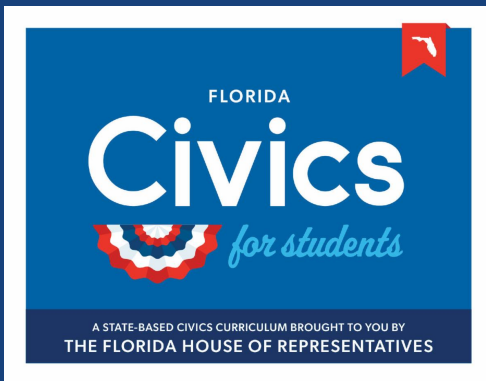
This week we encourage parents and K-5 readers to participate in the New Worlds Reading Initiative.

FLORIDA CIVICS FOR STUDENTS



During the first week of the 2022 Legislative Session, Speaker Sprowls unveiled the House's Civics curriculum for Florida's fourth-grade students. This makes the Florida House the first legislative body in the nation to create a Civics curriculum of this kind in the nation.
